

Ohio HOSA State Officer Application Procedure

State Officers will be elected by a combination of activities. Popular vote is only one part of the selection process. Offices will be assigned by the greatest total points earned, based on the officers' preferences. Points will be awarded as follows:

A. Application	10 points
B. Transcript	10 points
C. Written Test	20 points
D. Oral Presentation	20 points
E. Interview	40 points

The term of office for Ohio HOSA State Officers runs from July 1 through the following state and national conferences.

Fill out the application and make a copy for your records. Send the original and other required forms to the HOSA state advisor by the published deadline.

All Ohio HOSA officer candidates and elected state officers:

- Must be an active member of their local HOSA chapter
- Must maintain a cumulative average of 85 or "B"

State Officer Candidates will be permitted to give a 3-minute speech during the General Assembly at the State Leadership Conference. The voting delegates will vote by secret ballot to determine the state officers. Verbal campaigning is allowed – NO campaign materials are allowed.

The following items **MUST** be included as part of the officer application:

1. Candidate application form
2. Completed Nomination Form
3. Official transcript of grades
4. Information Form for uniform and business cards
5. Photo/Image Release Form
6. One page handwritten essay on "What I Can Contribute to HOSA"
