Health Careers 2C sponsored a Breast Cancer Awareness Day/Dress Down Day on Friday, October 21st.

Students were asked to donate \$1.00 to dress down for the day. Breast cancer pink ribbon stickers were given to students/staff who participated. The total collected was



\$450.26. The money was donated to the Cleveland Clinic Foundation Breast Cancer Research Fund.

On Friday, December 2nd, Health Careers 1C and 2C assisted with the American Red Cross Blood Drive. The junior students decorated Conference Room A in the Candy Land game theme. Students and staff who donated were given colored paper blocks to place from the start to the finish line on the duplicated board

game which had been placed on the large bulletin board in Conference Room A. Sixty-three pints of blood were donated and 86 people were inspired to try to donate.
