

Advisors

Check-in will be located inside the main doors (Door 1). One advisor per school should check-in and let the staff know if all students are present. You will be given a packet of information including schedules, tickets for lunch, rules, and a map. You will then be escorted to your “home room”.

At this point, I believe we will have enough judges that we should not need to ask advisors to assist with judging. Advisors should be able to remain with their students or at least supervise them (especially in their “home room” area.) If you note any students who are not yours but are misbehaving, kindly correct them and notify Perry adult staff if the behavior continues.

Due to the large numbers, we will be assigning each school a “Home Room”. Personal items should remain in that room, but please don’t leave anything of great value unless someone is remaining to monitor. Advisors are responsible for making sure students do not disturb anything in the room. You can move tables and chairs but will need to return them to their original position before attending the awards ceremony or leaving for the day.

No food or drinks are permitted in the “Home Room” area. Any food and drinks should be taken to the cafeteria for consumption.

Please encourage your competitors who have finished, or those who have time before their events, to attend the College and Career Fair, visit the SIM Station, or gather in the cafeteria to socialize. A major goal of HOSA is to begin networking! Let’s help them make that happen!

Just a quick note about the COMPETITION SCHEDULE.

We are putting the schedule together tomorrow and should have it to you by Saturday.

Testing will be on-line and there are three waves.

1st wave: 2 round competitions which need a test score to qualify for round 2, or need that score to be seeded in round 2.

2nd wave: On-line testing-only competitions

3rd wave: Test and skill competitions which perform skills 1st (less than 10 competitors or teams, so all would move on to skills).

Times for on-line testing will be 8:15am, 9:30am, 11:30am (some events may be scheduled as “to follow” the conclusion of skills)
